Thank you for your interest in A Child's Haven. We are a Waldorf Initiative in downtown Manhattan. As we move into our third year we are continuing our Parent Child classes and adding our Bridging class. The Bridge Program is for children 2 1/2 to 3 years old who are ready for more than Parent Child classes but aren't quite ready for a full time nursery program. This class offers families time to separate from their child gradually. Our teachers are working to establish the child's second attachment within the school setting. We recognize each family has individual needs and we will work with you through this process. Please note that while in the classroom parents will be interacting very little with their child. Once separation has occurred, parents will be asked to leave the classroom but remain on the premises engaging in craft activities and parent education. If you are not ready to begin a separation process with your child we encourage you to apply for one of our Parent Child classes.

The Bridge class will run on Thursdays and Fridays from 9:00 to 11:30 am (2.5 hours each time – 5 hours total a week). You will need to attend both class days (Thursday and Friday) to be in the program. The cost of this semester long program is \$2,250 for the 14 weeks; there is a \$500.00 deposit. **APPLICATION AND DEPOSIT DEADLINE IS JULY 1ST, 2008.** Classes start Thursday September 11th 2008.
